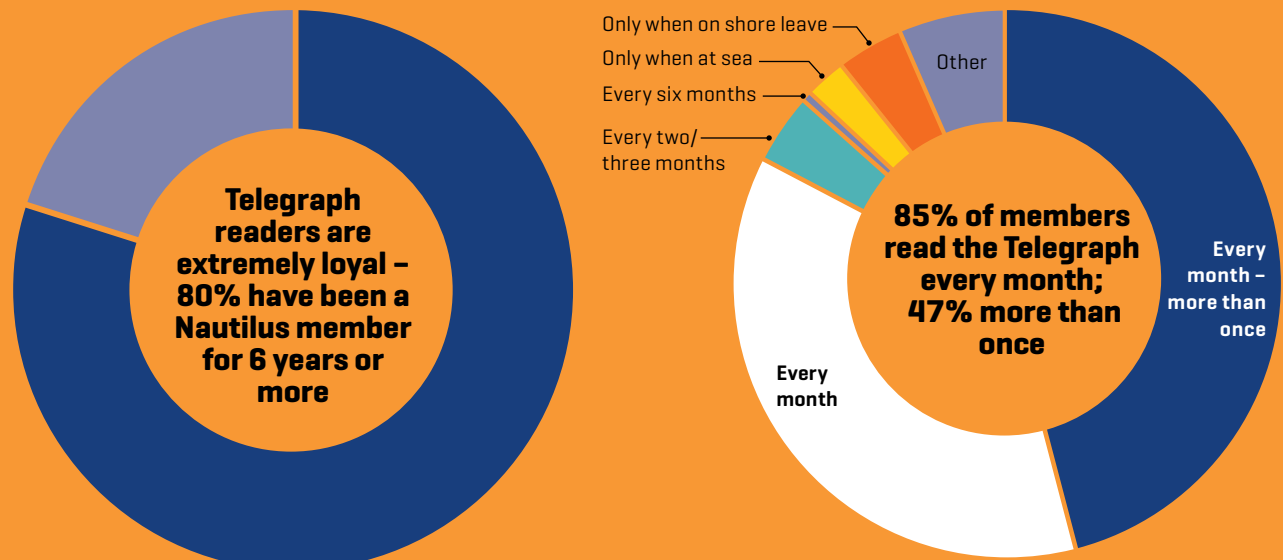

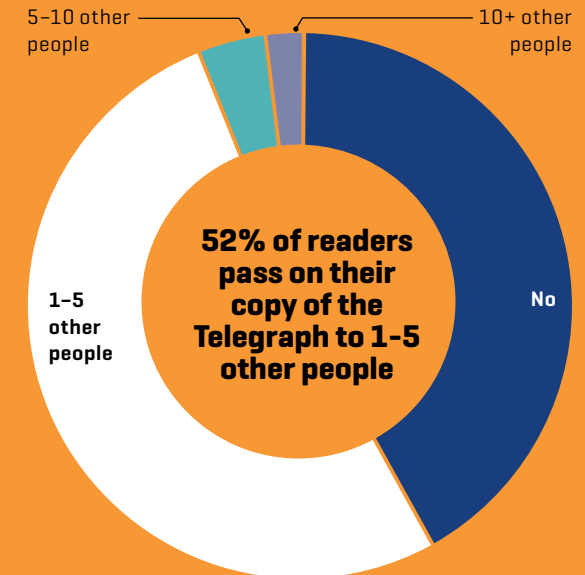
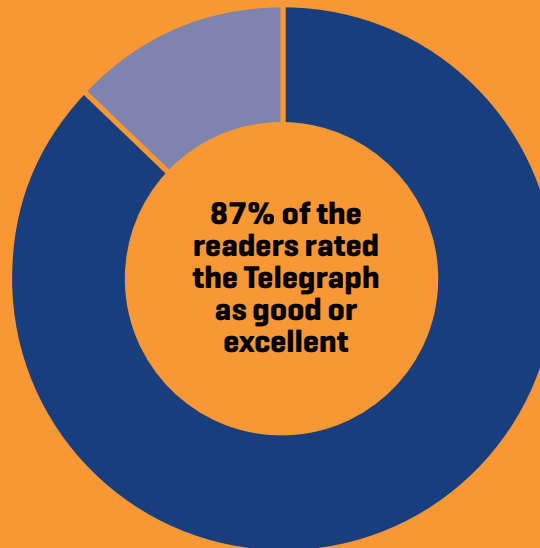
Editorial
